All fees must be paid before or on Registration Day, else the late registration fee\*\* will apply.

**\*\*Late Registrations.** If you are an **EXISTING** player and are not present on registration day to sign your yellow card (and have not made *prior* arrangements with a registrar) then you will be deemed a late registration. The \$30 late registration fee will be enforced and you will also need to go to a registrars' house at their convenience to finalise your registration. Avoid this situation by scheduling time to attend one of the registration days (and if not possible, contact a registrar prior to rego day).

### **How to register** – just 4 easy steps, and two you can do online!!

1. Complete the **player information sheet**:
  - i) Complete the form posted to you and bring it with you on rego day **OR**
  - ii) Enter your details online at our website!! All ages (no need to print anything or fill in a paper form)
2. Make your **payment**:
  - i) At a rego day by cash, cheque, EFTPOS or credit card **OR**
  - ii) **NEW!** Pay by direct deposit two days **prior** to a rego day (details in the online entry form. It is very important that you enter your AGE and SURNAME in the comments field, and keep a copy of your receipt of payment (hint: copy and paste it into an email to yourself if you can't directly email it).

Another hint: if you enter your details online *and* pay by direct deposit you will be in the Express lane to pick up your receipt on rego day.
3. Attend Registration Day to **sign your yellow card** (you **must attend rego day**, even if points 1 & 2 are done online)
4. Purchase your **uniform** at rego day (if required)

### **We welcome new players of all ages**

Spread the word!!! Please let your friends know that Registration day is on. New players of any age are always welcome so tell them about how great our club is!!

Cronulla RSL are offering **FREE Registration for 7 and 8 year old players** who turn up to register in person for Saturday netball on our registration days. Details can be entered online but no discount until registration is complete.

- *Nursery Netball* is for ages 6 and 7 year olds and is played on a weekday after school. No uniform is required for Nursery Netball. If desired, some Saturday morning games are organised & structured with other clubs towards the end of the season.
- *Modified Netball* is for 8 and 9 year olds & starts for children turning 8 this year. **7 year olds** who are in Year 2 at school may also play in the 8 year old teams but may need to revert to their own age group at 10 years of age. These games are played on Saturday mornings.
- *10 year olds* and above play normal netball rules with semis, finals & grand finals.
- *Seniors* (age 18+) have the options of joining us as a block team or as individuals

**Special tips for new players.** If your friends are coming let them know that they must bring:

- If aged 10+: *two* identical, colour, passport size photos to registration day
- If aged under 16: birth certificates or passports are required to be sighted at the time of registration

**Do you need to bring photos?** Your photos are essential to complete your registration. You will need to bring *two* identical, colour, passport size photos to registration day if you are:

- a new player: are aged 10 years and above
- an existing player who has not updated your photos in the last 3 years

## **Senior Block Teams**

Block teams are possible for senior teams (aged 18+). They must have between 8 and 12 players. *All members* must sign up on rego day else vacant positions may be filled at the committee's discretion. As for all teams, block teams must fulfil all club commitments (including canteen duty, **organising your own umpires**, active committee involvement, newsletter collection and fundraising).

**ENTER TEAMS ONLINE** The list of player names and contacts can also be advised online before registration day.

## **Umpiring**

Umpires get paid for umpiring based on their qualifications. Good umpires can earn good money!! So if you are interested and are 13 or older contact our Umpires Convenor, Vicki Johnson (0401 766 774, [pvakt@bigpond.net.au](mailto:pvakt@bigpond.net.au)). You will get training prior to the season commencing so you are ready to hit the courts armed with whistle, knowledge and experience. Give it a try – you are under no obligation to umpire if you don't like it, but if you do - think of the money you can earn!!!

If you already have umpiring qualifications and want to umpire this year see Vicki on registration day so they can put your details on the Paid Umpires list. This info can also be provided with your online registration.

**Seniors:** An umpiring levy is included in all senior players' registration fees, to assist in paying for umpires for junior games. This is not intended to discourage you from umpiring. *We very much want (and need!) seniors to umpire!! And you will be paid for these games!*

We greatly encourage all senior teams to provide umpires for some modified or junior games at Seymour Shaw / Bellingara netball courts on a Saturday morning (8.00am, 9.15am or 10.30am. You can choose the days to umpire, and the grade of the teams – let our Umpires Convenor Vicki Johnson know and she will allocate games to you.

Modified and junior games are particularly enjoyable and your experience is greatly appreciated by the players and their families – you don't need to be a brilliant umpire, and we can provide assistance to you if required (so please ask!).

**Uniforms** The total cost is \$85 for the skirt and top and will be available on Registration Day. Rugby jerseys are available too. We also sell second hand uniforms. If you have one to sell give our Uniform Officer, Sonja a ring – 0433 845 533 / 9525 9096.
