Semis, Finals and Grand finals are in the month of August.

Cronulla RSL Practical Grading:

The Practical grading is **compulsory** for **all junior players** aged 10 and over. You will be notified before this date if you are not required. Senior grading will only be held if required.

11 & 12 year olds will be **notified** of their grading day if required.

Teams will be finalised at grading, so if you know that someone intends to join but has not gotten around to it, tell them to get a move on!!! It is very important that you attend your grading so that all players and teams are properly graded. Failure to attend grading may mean that you miss out on a spot in the most appropriate team for you.

All teams 10 years to 16 years are required to grade. This is done by very capable and experienced graders. It is a very big job and is done to the best of their ability. Please have consideration for these volunteers and refrain the need to criticise. All decisions with regard to grading will be final.

SSNA Compulsory Practical Grading for 10 year olds:

- All 10 year old teams **must** also attend the SSNA practical grading at **Bellingara Courts** at **9.00am** on **Saturday 3 March 2012**.
- Please have your child in full club uniform – Club shirt & skirt, black briefs and white socks.

Coaches will be reminded closer to the date and will let teams know. Coaches will need to pick up their gear bags from Sally Parnell before this day. This is for the **10 year old teams**

only. Please ring Sally on 0404 196 338 to arrange pickup. (You will still need to attend the Coaches & Managers night to collect manuals, photos etc).

All other teams will need to pick up their bags on Coaches & Managers Night (see below).

Each team **must** supply an umpire on the day (it could be the coach, a mother, a father, brother or sister). If your team is having difficulty finding an umpire, please contact Vicki Johnson - 0401 766 774.

Coaches & Managers Night:

The **Coaches and Managers Night** will be held in the **Cocktail Lounge** of the Cronulla RSL Memorial Club on **Monday 12 March** at **7.30pm**. At this short informative meeting coaches, managers and committee members will have the opportunity to meet each other, collect their gear bags, ask questions and receive any information needed to start the season.

New coaches will need to attend an SSNA "Basic Coaching Course" at the start of the season which will be paid for by the club. As spaces are limited for courses, please ring Jo Neilson - 0412 413 954 to let her know of your interest. Course dates to be advised.

Coaches and Managers:

Coaches and Managers are needed for all the teams, junior and senior. Please help your child and the club by offering your services for these vital roles. Teams cannot play in the competition without these very important people. There are plenty of coaching courses available during the season to assist anyone willing to get involved. And you aren't just limited to the team your child is in to help out. If you would like to coach or manage another team.... just ask!

Fixture Books:

The fixture book will be issued to every team as soon as we receive them. It is usually **after** Day 1. The full draw will also be posted to the [SSNA website](#), as will the results of all games and the competition table for each grade. This is a great way to keep track of how your team is going.

Photos:

ALL players from **10 years to seniors** require photos to play netball. **2 identical passport size** photos are required at the time of registration. If you do not have these photos at the time of registration you may be asked get your photos before you can register. You are **not registered** until all photos, birth certificates, signatures etc, have all been accepted by a Registrar. So, don't delay in getting these requirements finalised otherwise, you may miss out on being placed in a team.

Umpiring:

Umpires for 10–16 year old junior teams will be allocated by the Umpire's Convenor. You will be given an umpiring roster at the beginning of the season. If your umpire does not turn up for any reason, please notify the Umpire Convenor.

All senior teams will need to organise their own umpire. An umpire list will be available within the next few weeks. You must notify Vicki as to who will be umpiring your games as soon as possible.

If you can assist at all with respect to umpiring (supervising junior umpires or offering to umpire yourself), or if you already have umpiring qualifications and would like to umpire this year please contact the Umpire Convenor so you can be rostered on.

The Section 1 Umpiring Exam can now be done online and at anytime throughout the year. The online exam provides instant results and a printable certificate. You can access the exam on the Netball Australia website www.netball.asn.au and click on the link "[Online Umpire Exam Centre](#)".

The **Umpires exam** is **compulsory** for all Junior players **13 years** and above. Good money can be made from umpiring, so start studying girls! Anyone who has failed in the past or wants to go for an umpiring badge will need to do the exam.

'U for Umpiring' books can be purchased from Ground Control at Bellingara Courts.

- The SSNA will be holding a **Beginners Umpire Course** at **Bellingara Courts** (date to be advised). There are limited places so if you wish to attend please contact Vicki Johnson to put forth your interest. If you are starting umpiring this year you need to attend this course. This is compulsory for you to umpire so put this date in your diary NOW. If you would like to go for a Badge this year please leave your name with Vicki and she will allocate you with a coach and games.

Current Umpiring rates per game are:

Beginner Umpire	\$10
Junior Umpire	\$15 (umpires who can umpire 10's to 15's unsupervised)
Senior Umpire	\$20 (umpires who can umpire 17's and Seniors unsupervised)
National Badges	\$25

- A **Level 1 Accreditation Course** will be held in **2012**. More details are the season commences.

Finally, we keep our Umpires up to date via email or the club website. Please ensure our Umpires Convenor has your current email address so that you are kept up to date with rosters and training. If we do not have a correct email address you will not be rostered for games.

Team Duties:

- **Canteen**

Every team will be rostered a time to work in the canteens at Seymour Shaw and Bellingara on the day allocated by the SSNA. You will be given at least two weeks notice of this time and we will do our best to make sure it is close to the time and at the location that you playing for seniors and for juniors it maybe during the time your child is playing. As this is compulsory, we will appreciate your cooperation in providing enough people (aged 16 years and over).

- **Umpiring Modifieds**

Umpires especially for the modified games are needed as young beginning umpires do not have the experience or skills to help our youngest players develop – senior players are required, even if they have little experience in umpiring, as they do have a presence and confidence on court that is vital. The [rules are posted on the website](#) and there will be an optional modified umpiring training course prior to the season commencing, so please consider giving one morning of your season to the kids – they'll be the ones umpiring you in 10 years time.

- **Monthly Meetings**

Meetings are held at 7.30pm on the first Monday of each month at the Cronulla RSL Memorial Club. **It is compulsory that every team be represented at every meeting.**

Training and forfeits:

Please contact Liz O'Brien -0401 002 910 to book your court and timeslot. Courts are limited, so be quick. If your team is going to forfeit you must notify Liz **at least** 24 hours before the game to avoid a \$100 fine for Seniors and \$50 fine for Juniors.
